On Friday 20th prayers were said for Elsa Burt who has been in hospital with an infection. On Saturday prayers were sought for Nancy who had fallen down some steps and damaged her ankle and was on crutches. On Tuesday Chris Nash asked for prayers as he was waiting in hospital to have surgery. Later Chris reported he was out of bed and moving about. On the same day Victoria asked for prayers for her 4 year old niece Phoebe Child, pictured below with her uncle Jack. Phoebe has Downs Syndrome. She has undergone heart operations and has spent a lot of time in and out of hospital. She had been being treated recently for Pneumonia but was asked to return to hospital as a second look at some x-rays suggested she



was suffering from heart failure. Tests showed this had been the situation for some time and they were surprised she had survived. Doctors need to replace her pace maker as that is what they think is causing the problem and if they can't Phoebe won't survive. However, they have discovered a blood clot in her heart and they are unable to remove the pace maker unless they can disperse the clot. If the clot dislodges it will kill her. A lot of things have to come together rapidly to get Phoebe through as she is very poorly. Paul, who was a member of SBC, and now a Vicar in South Shields, and Miriam, his wife, and their three other children are in a very scary place at the moment and ask for prayers that Phoebe, who starts school in September, survives this ordeal.
