Believers Stand Strong Despite Arson Attack

Open Doors 07 March 2018 Christian Believers in Kyrgyzstan have restored their church after an arson attack.

The 40 members of a Baptist church in Kajisay – a small town in the Issyk-Kul region that borders China – feared for their safety when attackers set fire to their church on 2nd January. They were told by police that the attack was 'organised by those who don't like your church and Christianity in the midst of a Muslim country'. Yet despite the threats and extensive damage, the churchgoers kept coming every Sunday to worship God in their burnt-out building. "The 'enemy' wanted to frighten us through that fire, but it didn't work," said one of the members. "The Christians of Kajisay started to meet for prayer, worship and Bible study more often than before, even though it was very uncomfortable in the burned building."

They also worked hard to clean and repair their building - a renovation which was partly supported by Open Doors.
