Just after his fifth birthday Harry was diagnosed with cancer of the spine. After two operations which were unable to remove the tumour completely Harry had to learn to walk again. The cancer



has now spread to his brain and Harry is undergoing long term treatment.

The questions Harry asks are heart breaking 'Why does God make tumours?' 'Why does this happen to me?' His mum tells him. "Because Harry you are amazing and you can cope with anything." You can help Harry "cope with anything" by helping to raise the £25,000 to pay for the much needed

specialist equipment and improved living space in his home to give him some independence.
