I am currently having a flair up of pain which has landed me on high strength pain killers. Things haven't been going so well lately with my condition and to cap it all the pain management team has cancelled the last two appointments, due to a doctors illness. I am in agony and the heat isn't helping. I am hoping that this time the appointment will look into a long-term epidural reducing the pain. I know there is no cure but I would be happy if I could just manage it better, as at the moment I am not managing it at all. Thank you." UPDATES. Jenny thanked everyone for their prayers. Saying "There's a lot to thank God for. The growth of the tumour is small but considered to need treatment and is suitable for a single stereotactic radiotherapy. This should happen sometime before Christmas." Diana posted "Thank you for your prayers for Attic and Asma and the safe natural delivery of their baby, who safely arrived." Victoria said "Thank you for your prayers for Poppy. The consultant said he is happy to wait until she has had her operation before reducing her treatment. Her kidney levels and function were fine"
